



## Working Abroad

For IFNA, a nurse anesthetist is a person who has completed a program of basic nursing education and basic nurse anesthesia education and is qualified and authorized in his/her country to practice nurse anesthesia. Nurse Anesthetist is a general title for nurses working in anesthesia with a specific education. The title could be: Nurse Specialized (or Specialist) in Anesthesia or Anesthetic Nurse.

Language requirement	The institution or organization one is applying to  For example, if applied to enroll in Nurse or Nurse Anesthesia school, you must pass English.
Education requirements to become a nurse	High school graduate (passed 12th grade).  To practice as a Nurse, one must pass an certification examination by Liberian Board of Nursing and Midwifery (LBNM) and for Nurse anesthetist, passed the certification examination by Liberian Association of Nurse Anesthetist (LANA) and Liberian Board of Nursing and Midwifery (LBNM).
Education requirements to become a nurse anesthetist	To become a nurse Anesthetist, one must be a registered nurse with current license, worked for at least two years in emergency department or obstetrics ward, passed entrance and interview by post basic nursing school offering Anesthesia, attend the school for at least two years, graduate and passed certification examination by LANAL and LBNM.
