



Working Abroad

For IFNA, a nurse anesthetist is a person who has completed a program of basic nursing education and basic nurse anesthesia education and is qualified and authorized in his/her country to practice nurse anesthesia. Nurse Anesthetist is a general title for nurses working in anesthesia with a specific education. The title could be: Nurse Specialized (or Specialist) in Anesthesia or Anesthetic Nurse.

Language requirement	All the examination is in Traditional Chinese. Our official language is Mandarin. Therefore, although there are no request of language competence test, but you must be able to write and speak our language very well
Education requirements to become a nurse	Bachelor's degree
Education requirements to become a nurse anesthetist	At least finish one-year training program of nurse anesthetist

Required process to document competency to practice as a nurse anesthetist*, for example, certification	All nurse anesthetists are certified by the program holders
Visa requirements	One must apply the work visa to legally work in Taiwan. For the detail please check the website of working development agency minister of labor https://www.wda.gov.tw/en/
Others	For medical personnel, one must get the professional license before practice
