After applying for renewal of level 2 Recognition the program was evaluated following the renewal process described in the International Federation of Nurse Anesthetists ANESTHESIA PROGRAM APPROVAL PROCESS (APAP): OPERATIONAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES (pg7-8).

A current curriculum was presented to actualize the information about the program. Student and faculty evaluations were carried out and evaluated in March 2018. Following the review of all information, renewal of Recognition was granted based on the program's meeting eligibility requirements, ability to comply with the IFNA Education Standards, and attempts to continually improve.

Curriculum Overview

This is a 36 month program of study with a two-phase design. Phase I is 14 months in length and primarily composed of didactic activity with very little clinical activity. Phase II is 22 months in length and is primarily clinical activity. Clinical activity takes place in Clinical Practicum I, II, III, IV, and V.
