Curriculum Design: Anesthetic Nurse Specialist, LAB University of Applied Sciences

The studies include five modules that examine key themes in anesthetic nursing: patient safety, clinical decision-making skills, consultative competence, teamwork, and emergency management skills. The studies include a practical training module worth five ECTS units, which must be performed in a separately defined work unit other than the student's original work community. For instance, the practical training can be arranged as a rotating job according to the demand for expertise and the employment situation of the organisation and the student. Students are responsible for acquiring practical training positions at an appropriate time. All the modules included in the studies aim to strengthen and expand previous expertise and to develop advanced professional capabilities that allow the students to act in multidisciplinary anesthetic nursing environments.
